

HOW TO APPLY TO AN UNIVERSITY IN ITALY

HELLO!

And we know how difficult and exciting can be the way of an applicant! To make it easier for you, we have written step-by-step actions and in this guide you can find everything!

Let's take a look at the details!



CHOOSING A UNIVERSITY

This is one of the most important steps. First, we choose a profession, then we look at the number of places for foreign students for this profession at different universities and after that, we determine where we want to enroll.

You should know: In Italy, you can apply to only one university and one specialty.

COLLECTING DOCUMENTS

- Make an apostille on a school certificate and diploma, if you have one.
- Collect family documents to apply for a scholarship and determine the amount of the state fee for study: a certificate of family composition and a certificate of income of each family member. (Correctly determine who is officially part of your family)
- Translate a school certificate, diploma, and academic certificate and all documents for the scholarship by an interpreter accredited by the Italian Consulate.
- Give the translated documents for legalization. (Remember that in order to enter an Italian university, you must study for at least 12 years. Therefore, if you have completed 11 years of school, check the availability of preparatory programs that will be credited to you for 1 year of study).



SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

- First, you must apply for transfer to the selected Italian university. This can be done through a single platform of Italian universities – Universitaly.
- Apply for a hostel or find an apartment to rent.
- Draw up a lease agreement.



OBTAINING A VISA

- Wait for a response from the University and apply for a student visa.

! Remember that medical insurance is required for a visa. It is better to take state insurance immediately in Italy because it can be used for the mandatory submission of documents for a temporary residence permit.

- Pass an interview at the Italian Consulate and show them the originals of the necessary documents: a visa application form for study, an invitation from the university, a financial guarantee, proof of residence in Italy.



INTERVIEW

- Come to Italy to take a test for knowledge of the general culture of Italy and knowledge of the Italian language.
- According to the knowledge of the language, you can provide a certificate. (Taking the test on the spot at the university is much easier.)

GETTING A SCHOLARSHIP

- A scholarship for free study in Italy can be obtained if your family income does not exceed 21,000 – 25,000 euros per year (depending on the region).
- We make an Italian-style family income declaration to determine the amount of the state fee for studying.
- We apply for a scholarship, attaching the necessary documents: application, family income certificates. If you do not apply for a scholarship, you will have to pay a state fee for tuition, its amount depends on income. On average, it ranges from 200 to 400 euros per year (again, it depends on your income).



INTEGRATION INTO THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS

- Apply through the post office for a residence permit and book an appointment with the police to provide original documents and fingerprinting.
- Required documents: application form, university admission confirmation, passport copy, medical insurance.
Start studying
- Wait for the scholarship results, they usually come within 1-2 months.
- Go to lectures and study well to pass 1-2 exams to extend a temporary residence permit and 3-4 exams to receive a scholarship for the second year.

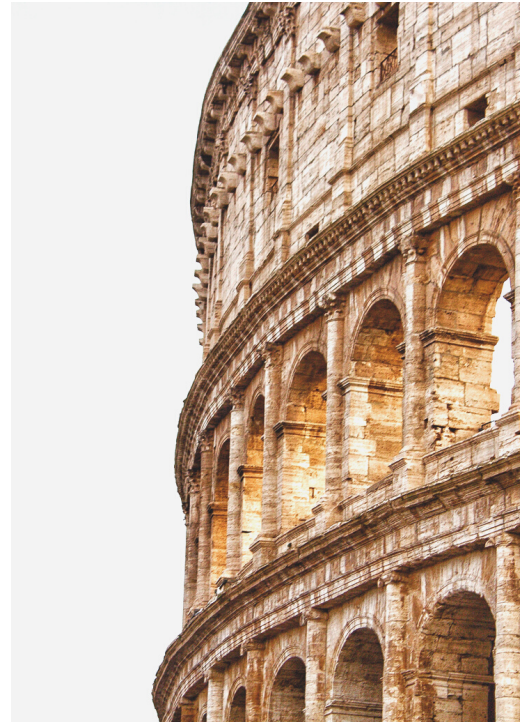
